

Why we take Panoramic x-rays

X-rays are one of the most important diagnostic tools in an oral surgery office. In our practice we use digital x-ray equipment to minimize radiation. Our standard of care requires a panoramic x-ray for all patients. These films check for pathology in the roots, sinuses, nerves and jawbones.

If you have taken a different scan of your patient (CBCT or PA) you are welcome to send it along with the referral. Please keep in mind we will still need the complete panoramic x-ray to see the mouth in it's entirely (versus segments).

We require a new panoramic x-ray for any patient whose current panoramic is one year or older. Should you have any questions, we invite you to call our office to further discuss.
